Section 5 – Pre-Hearing Submissions

Section 6 – Motions

Any motions shall be filed by ______ or no later than ______ days before the hearing.

Section 7 – Amendment

The parties may jointly agree to modify the HSDP. R. 701-115.6(3). Modifications to the HSDP shall be done by filing of an amended HSDP.

If one party seeks to modify the HSDP, the party must show good cause for the modification.

Section 8 – Pre-hearing Conference

A party may request a pre-hearing conference to resolve any discovery dispute. R. 701-115.6(2).

Section 9 – Settlement

The parties shall immediately notify PAAB of a settlement agreement.

Section 10 – Continuances

Continuances are discouraged and will only be granted for good cause. R. 701-115.8(4). The parties should discuss continuances before filing a motion with PAAB.

- Uncontested continuances: An amended HSDP should be filed with the continuance motion.
- Contested continuances: The party requesting the continuance should file a proposed HSDP with the continuance motion. Any resistance should state objections to the proposed HSDP.

Section 11 – Consequence of Non-Compliance

A party that does not comply with the HSDP must show good cause for not complying and that the other party is not substantially prejudiced. R. 701-115.6(4). Failing to comply with the HSDP may result in sanctions, including but not limited to the exclusion of evidence or dismissal of the appeal. Iowa R. Civ. P. 1.517(2) and 1.602(5). PAAB may resolve disputes by reference to this HSDP or any amended HSDP.

Section 12 – Acknowledgement (Select one)

- The parties agree and consent to be bound by the deadlines in this HSDP. The parties request
 PAAB enter this HSDP in the record and set the hearing date as stated in Section 2.
- The HSDP is filed without the opposing party's consent or agreement. The undersigned affirms they have made two good faith attempts to complete the HSDP with the opposing party, or this proposed HSDP is being filed with a contested continuance motion.
